

Refugees welcome here Let the children in now!

After finally giving in to attempts to allow at risk unaccompanied refugee children into Britain the Tories now claim that it could take seven months for them to act.

Tory immigration minister James Brokenshire said that refugee children might not be allowed in until “the end of the year”.

The Tories finally accepted an amendment to their immigration bill moved by Lord Dubs, who escaped Nazi persecution as a child, to

allow unaccompanied children into Britain. But they only accepted the amendment once a commitment to allow 3,000 children in was dropped.

The Tories’ behaviour shows no understanding for the plight of children traumatised by their experience of fleeing war and poverty. They are vulnerable and urgently need care. We demand the Tories allow the children into Britain now!
